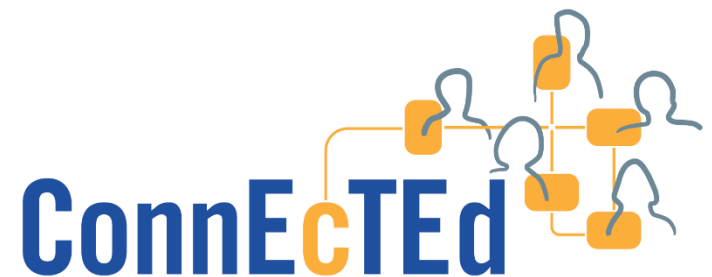

1) Content

Digital transformation in Foreign Language (Teacher) Education



- Live webinar (recorded for the project website)
- Speakers can be colleagues working in ConnEcTEd, but you can also invite speakers, e.g., from your institution
- Possible perspectives on the main theme
 - Good practices in the use of digital tools in FLT (focus on schools or TE)
 - Research findings of digital transformation in FLTE
 - Discussion on future possibilities / challenges in digital transformation
 - Etc.
- Share your chosen topic(s) with Helsinki (to avoid overlapping)
 - Shared document in Teams > 4) Intellectual Outputs > IO7 > Video 2 - webinars

2) Technical specifications

- 2-3 partner institutions collaborate / work independently on each webinar
 - Proposal for partner collaboration:
 - 1) Zagreb-Oslo-Freiburg (PH)
 - 2) Nice-Freiburg (ALU)
 - 3) Helsinki-Turku – **webinar was organized on May 3rd, 2022, to be published in June/July.**
- Each pair/group organizes and records their own webinar
- Duration: 1h
- Lingua franca is **English**
- The recordings will be published on the project website
 - Closed captions (EU Accessibility directive)
 - Only include the presentations in the final cut (GDPR)
 - Consent needed from the speakers to record the webinar and share it on the project website

3) Some tips

- Plan ahead: think of later uses for the recording (or the live webinar event), e.g., in your courses
- Prepare for technical issues during the webinar:
 - ask for the presentation materials beforehand
 - record with at least two devices
 - Zoom pre-settings
 - 1) mute audio and hide video for participants upon entry
 - 2) assign co-hosts
 - 3) chat only to hosts (fewer interruptions)
 - 4) waiting room
 - 5) recording: speaker view
